## BELLWETHER TRIAL CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 2:

In accordance with the court's January 26, 2024 Bellwether Trial Case Management Order ("Bellwether Trial Order No. 1") (Dkt. 521), the court selects the following plaintiffs for the bellwether trials:

Bellwether Trial No. 1 (June 2025): Gayle Tarloff, 23-CV-5793 (EDNY Pool)

Bellwether Trial No. 2 (August 2025): Geraldine Larson, 22-CV-6643 (EDNY Pool)

Bellwether Trial No. 3 (TBD 2025): Dana Kessler Kramer, 23-CV-658 (National Pool)

In the court's Bellwether Trial Order No. 1, the court provided that it would select two cases from each pool for a total of four cases. *See* Bellwether Trial Order No. 1 ¶ 11. However, for the reasons outlined in their bellwether trial briefing, only one plaintiff—Kessler Kramer—is an appropriate bellwether plaintiff for the National Pool. (*See* Pl. Mem. (Dkt. 583); Exactech Mem. (Dkt. 584); Exactech Reply (Dkt. 588); Pl. Reply (Dkt. 589).)<sup>2</sup> For the fourth bellwether trial, the parties are DIRECTED to confer and submit a consensus pick from the plaintiffs in the National Preliminary Pool by May 3, 2024. The submission should include what factors make the proposed plaintiff representative such that he or she is an appropriate bellwether

plaintiff. If the parties are unable to agree on a joint choice for the final bellwether plaintiff,

by May 3, 2024, the parties shall each submit a proposed bellwether plaintiff from the National

Preliminary Pool to the court for its selection, with a brief explanation of why the plaintiff is

representative of the pool of plaintiffs.

The Clerk of Court is respectfully DIRECTED to enter a copy of this Order on the indi-

vidual docket for each of the three selected bellwether plaintiffs and transfer the three

individual cases to the MDL docket, 22-MD-3044.
